#### Selection

- 2. The number of places available is limited. Participation will be subject to a selection procedure. Selection will be dependant on:
  - i. the relevance of the seminars to the professional life of the applicant;
  - ii. the ability to disseminate what they have learnt;
  - iii. geographical and linguistic balance among the participants will also be sought;
  - iv. priority will be given to applicants who have not already participated in one of the earlier editions of this event:
  - v. only one person per institution may be accepted.
