### 1. RIGHT TO ENTER

NO EXPULSION

(SHOULD BE) OBVIOUS IN ITALY (ARTICLE 19 CONSOLIDATED ACT ON MIGRATION (TUI)

NOT THAT OBVIOUS IN NEIGHBOURING COUNTRIES

### 1. .....RIGHT TO ENTER

NO EXPULSION FROM ITALY

A)MINORS READMITTED (COURT OF ROME: Readmission to Greece from Brindisi port - Order to issue a visa to apply for asylum in Italy) **HOWEVER** 

#### B) PREVENTED TO ENTER:

- indirect refoulement in the Meidterranean Sea;
- Inibition of entry through joint patrols ( italian and slovenian police at Slovenian border)

### 2. RIGHT TO STAY

GETTING A PERMIT TO STAY FOR MINOR AGE EXTENDABLE (IN SOME CASES) UP TO 21 YEARS AND CONVERTIBLE INTO:

A) PERMIT TO STUDY

B) PERMIT TO WORK

### 2. .... AND TO SEEK ASYLUM (when minors)

GETTING A PERMIT TO STAYAS ASYLUM SEEKERS

AS VULNERABLE: NOT ALLOWED ACCELERATED PROCEDURES

IN CASE OF DENIAL:

CONVERTIBLE (AS THE MINOR AGE PERMIT)

Right to enter and to regularise their position on the national territory

Subordinate to:

the way of arrival

the geographical area of arrival

# 3. RIGHT NOT TO BE DETAINED AND TO DEDICATED FACILITIES

ACCOMMODATION

A FEW DAYS IN FIRST ACCOMMODATION
FACILITIES THEN MOVED TO PROPER
ACCOMMODATION

LAW( ZAMPA LAW)




LAW (DL 133/2023)

Only in case of:

- doubts on the personal age
- Lack of identification documents

- Multidisciplinary approach
- no invasive methods
- benefit of the doubt





AGE ASSESSMENT

D.L. 133/2023: IN CASE OF SUBSTANTIAL MULTIPLE, CLOSELY ARRIVALS

- TOTAL DEROGATION FROM ORDINARY PROCEDURE
- RISK OF NULLIFYING GUARANTEES

- WIDE DISCRETION FOR SECURITY FORCES
- X RAYS
- NO PRESUMPTION OF MINOR AGE
- NO MULTIDISCIPLINARY APPROACH
- ORAL VALIDATION BY PUBLIC PROSECUTOR


